Alexis Martinez Castorena, age 20, was tragically murdered outside of his mom's house July 25th, 2022 in Milwaukee, WI. While having a conversation with his brother and cousin, they were targeted by individuals walking by, and those individuals who have not been identified, began an altercation that resulted in Alexis and his brother getting shot. They were both hospitalized, but Alex did not make it.

Alex was born on September 7th, 2001 in Milwaukee, WI to Graciela Castorena Rangel and Enrique Martinez Romero. He grew up very closely with his two siblings, Gabriela and Fernando Martinez and his grandparents, uncles, aunts and cousins. When Alex was still a child, his father, Enrique, remarried to Maria Rodriguez. He then gained two additional brothers, Emiliano Garcia Jr and Enrique Octavio Martinez. Throughout his lifetime, Alex enjoyed playing soccer, spending time with friends, and burning out his Mamalona. He met Angie Arana in high school, and after three years together they had their baby boy, Thiago Alexis Martinez Arana. He loved spending most of his time with his small family, Angie and Thiago.

Alex had big dreams, but he always mentioned he wanted to travel around the world. Angie hopes she fulfills that dream for him, along with their son.
