Dean was transferred to Madison's Truex Air Force Base after Arlene contracted polio while pregnant with Rhonda. As the family grew, he transferred to the 440th Wing at Mitchell Field in Milwaukee eventually working at Delco supporting the NASA Apollo missions. They built their home in South Milwaukee where they stayed until the kids were grown.

They traveled extensively in their RV for over 20 years and saw a majority of the states in the US. For a portion of their life, they were snow birds traveling between Christmas Mountain in Wisconsin Dells and Hill Country RV Resort in New Braunfels, Texas.

Dean enjoyed golfing having had a hole-in-one on two occasions, deer hunting in Texas, country music and shows at the Crystal Grand in Wisconsin

Dells. After they were done traveling, they resided in Reedsburg Wisconsin before moving to New Berlin to be closer to kids, grandkids and great grandkids.
