He fought not only in World War II but he also fought for us kids. His dedication to both will forever be in our hearts and memories. He never wanted us to worry about him. Even after we were all adults, he was the strong Dad, “don’t worry about it”. The epitome of being from the Greatest Generation. Us kids couldn’t worry, but through the tremendous kindness and strength of Michele, Jay and Eddie, he would let them help him. He gave us his sarcasm “can’t find your mouth?”, “roll me a square one”, “don’t you people eat?”, “how about that one Jillie?”, “Back when Moby Dick was a minnow, hey Annie?, I made that one up, ha, ha”, and his sense of humor. Every day as we all get older our mannerisms and likeness of you gets stronger. Just look at our Davey, Dad’s spitting image, his younger “twin”. 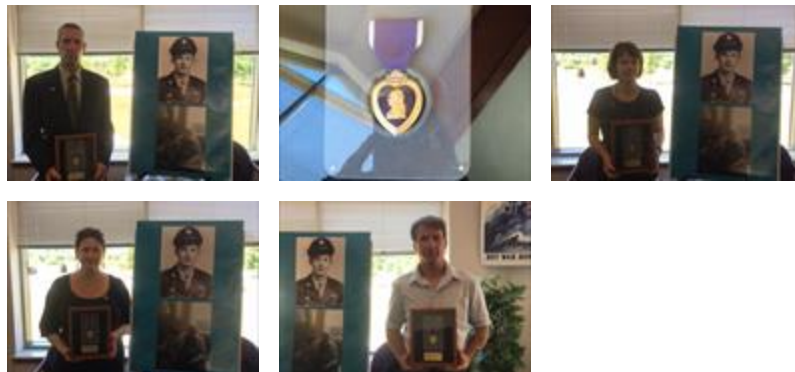

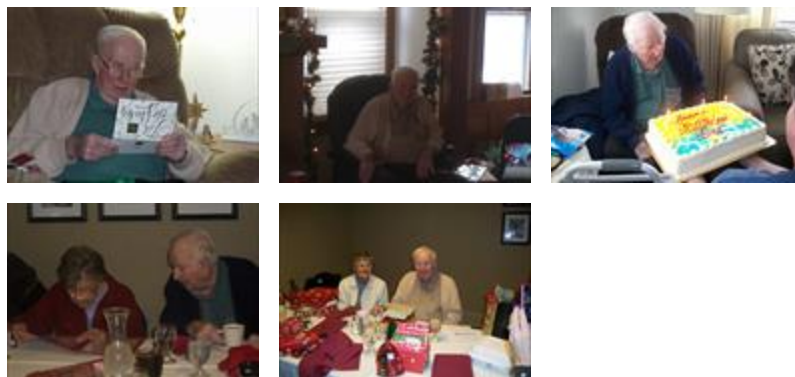

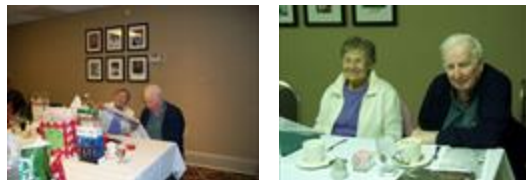
