Jon R. Cindric, age 71, of Milwaukee, passed away on August 20, 2025. Born and raised in Milwaukee, Jon's life was one built on love, laughter, hard work, and devotion to his family.

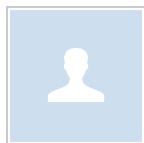
