“ I knew when I didn't get an Elvis birthday card in January 2022, something was not right with my dear friend Kathy. She and I became friends when I moved to Milwaukee in 1968 years and started working at INA where Kathy worked. I tried calling her and got the message that her phone had been disconnected. This confirmed my concern that I'd lost my special friend.

Kathy and I shared so many memories through the years. Our biggest "fun" was attending concerts together. I was never a big fan of Tom Jones, but made a deal with her: if she'd go to an Elvis concert with me, I'd give in and go to see Tom Jones with her. This led to us seeing Tom several times in Vegas (where she tossed panties onto his stage) and seeing Elvis live three times in Milwaukee. Her precious mother Anna stood in line for hours to get tickets for us while we worked for some of the Elvis concerts.

In 1971 my daughter Paulette was born and I asked Kathy to be her Godmother. I left INA after this, but our friendship continued until Kathy's passing. We continued to enjoy concerts together, a favorite being Lionel Richie with Tina Turner at Alpine. Her nephew Jay with a friend and my Paulette attended this one with us.

Kathy and I started sending each other Elvis cards for every special holiday or occasion - for more years than I can remember. She treasured hers and I hate to think of them finding their next home being a trash can somewhere. One year when she couldn't get out to get an Elvis Christmas card - she was in the hospital for one of her many hospital stays, she got a nurse to get her paper, stamp, envelope and drew a picture of Elvis to send me as my card. She did a darn good job with the picture and this mailing is a favorite from her through all these years.

I will miss the Elvis cards and especially my friend Kathy. She and I grieved the loss of my Paulette June 2020. Now she can rest in peace with her Goddaughter
