Manuela Morales (nee Gonzalez) was born January 1, 1940 to the late Martin Gonzalez & Cecilia Aviles in Moca, Puerto Rico. She was the sister of Antonio, Israel, Jose, Maria, Isaura, Nilda & Gloria. In 1986 she moved from her home in Moca, Puerto Rico to Milwaukee Wisconsin. She was wife to the late Concepcion Morales and a mother to two sons, Jose Concepcion Morales & Hilberto Morales. She was a grandmother to 5 & a great grandmother to 7, an aunt & a cousin to many. She would often prepare pasteles from her home in Milwaukee. She loved to play dominoes in her spare time & visit her sisters whenever she could. She spent winters in Texas with her son Hilberto & summers with her other son Jose. Manuela passed away April 29th, 2024 surrounded by loved ones at the age of 84 years.
