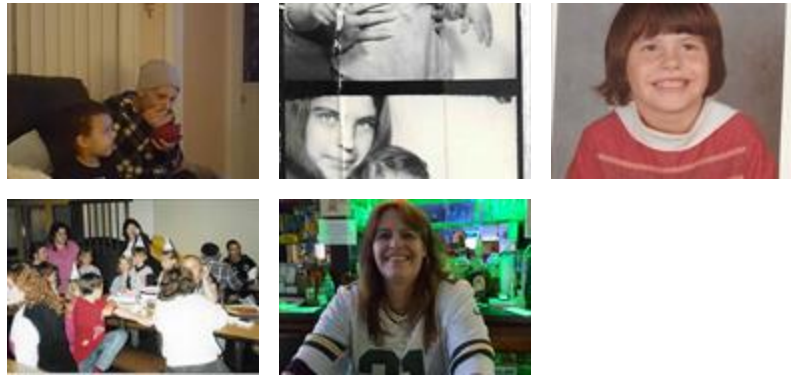
“ I was fourteen when Sandy was born. I would rush home from school to hold and play with this sweet baby. It is so difficult so say goodbye to the baby of our family.
