Anthony M. Kosinski Sr. (Tony) returned home on April 19, 2023, at age 86. Tony was born in 1937 to Anthony Joseph and Mary (née Schlack) Kosinski at his grandparents' home on the south side of Milwaukee. He attended Saint Adalbert School and Boys Technical High School. He started his career working for the Milwaukee Journal doing various jobs. He became an electrical journeyman after completion of coursework at MATC. Tony then worked for Pawling and Hernischfeger (P&H) for more than 40 years as a lead electrician. He was immensely proud of his time at P&H and spoke of it often with family members and friends. Upon retirement, Tony moved to the Lake Arrowhead area, where he stayed for 25 years before resettling in Menomonee Falls. His grandchildren fondly remember visiting him "up north." Tony loved his retirement homes but had an affinity for Milwaukee. He told stories about riding the streetcar and visiting supper clubs. During his long life, Tony was married 3 times, all of whom have preceded him in death.
